

The City Council of the City of Eminence, Kentucky met in a public hearing and special session on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 at 6:15 p.m. at the Eminence City Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Drane Stephens and the following members present: Danny Meadows, Polly Troxell, Leo Mason, Joey Bell, Fred Downey and Lee Ann Armstrong. Absent was none. Other individuals present were City Attorney William Brammell and City Clerk Sandra Doane.

Mayor Stephens called the public hearing to order at 6:15 p.m.

Pledge of allegiance held.

Subject: Property Tax Public Hearing - Mayor Stephens asked for comments or questions. None presented. Clerk Doane stated no written or oral comments had been received from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

Mayor Stephens adjourned the public hearing at 6:28 p.m. and called the regular session to order with the same people as listed above in attendance.

Subject: Ad Valorem Tax Ordinance – Mayor Stephens asked council if they had any additional comments or any changes to the rates they wanted to make prior to the second reading. No one did. Attorney Brammell held the second reading of the ad valorem tax ordinance setting the rate at 31.6 per \$100 assessment for real property and 31.6 per \$100 assessment for personal property and 26.6 cents per \$100 assessment for motor vehicles and watercrafts rates for the 2017/2018 tax year. Motion made by Member Meadows and seconded by Member Armstrong to adopt the ad valorem tax ordinance as read with the above tax rates. On a call of vote by Clerk Doane, all members present voted “Yea”.

With no further business to be discussed, motion made by Member Armstrong and seconded by Member Downey to adjourn. All members present voted “Yea”. Meeting adjourned at 6:37 p.m.
